"The Three Days"



The word Triduum comes from Latin for "the three days". It refers to the liturgical season between Lent and the Easter Season. The Triduum begins the evening of Holy Thursday, reaches its high point in the Easter Vigil, and closes with evening prayer on Easter Sunday. The liturgies of the Triduum are actually considered one liturgy spread over three days and is the culmination of the entire liturgical year. Even though we can not gather as a community for prayer and worship, we hope to provide ideas on how to live this holiest of weeks at home. We encourage you to participate in the live streamed liturgies and then choose a few of these resources based on the age of the members of your family to engage more deeply in this holy time.
