Easter Season

The Easter Season in the Catholic Church lasts 50 days after Easter and includes feasts of the Ascension and Pentecost. Throughout this season we celebrate Christ's resurrection and its power over sin and death.

Today we celebrate Pentecost, the birthday of the Church. Originally a Jewish feast, it was on this day that the Holy Spirit came upon the disciples in the upper room and bestowed upon them the gifts necessary to evangelize and build the Church. The entire Acts of the Apostles is the story of that same Holy Spirit leading the Apostles to spread the faith and the good news of the resurrected Jesus Christ.



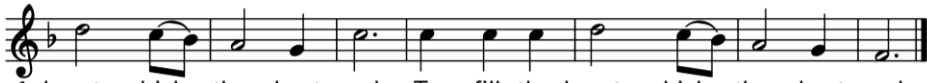

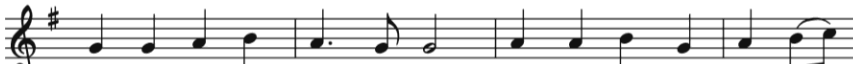
