Why a Confirmation Conversation "interview" for the Candidate?

The Confirmation Conversation "interview" has many purposes:

<u>First</u>, it gives Christy interaction time with the student in order for them to get to know each other and to build a trust that might not have previously been there.

<u>Second</u>, this conversation helps determine which mentor is best for the candidate.

<u>Lastly</u>, this gives the teen another opportunity to practice the interview process.

Before attending the Confirmation Conversation:

1. Please have ready a letter to your mentor:

- Start your letter of with "Dear Mentor,"
- in your letter include the following:
 - · why you would like to be confirmed
 - how you believe this preparation will help you grow in your faith
 - how you see your mentor helping you through this process
 - anything else you feel that your mentor should know

Questions that could be asked during the conversation:

- 1. Background of who you are, favorite hobbies, dreams, who your friends are, etc.
- 2. Why be Confirmed? How will it help you become the best version of yourself?
- 3. How have you served your community in the past? Are you a part of any service-oriented groups now?
- 4. Talk about your relationship with God.
- 5. What support/relationships do you have in your faith journey right now?
- 6. What HABITS do you plan to work on this year? You will receive this after your Confirmation Conversation.
