a. Annual Diocessan Appeal update

St. Francis met our goal! The diocese rolled back all parish goals by 5%. ADA number for this year comes out next week. It is expected to be similar to last years; it is based on a 3 year running average

- b. Technology: Sound is now figured out; speakers have been adjusted; we now have at least 20 hearing assistive devices available at the mass coordinator table; screens are now available at all masses for song lyrics
- c. Regathering: Lent begins the 17th of February. Ashes are now sprinkled on the top of the head (this is done in some other parts of the world). Bishop Joensen has extended the mask mandate through Divine Mercy Sunday April 11th. We are still in phase 3 of regathering. Working on plans for school Mass for all kids to go sometime during the week; there is now a 250-300 person cap per Mass.
- d. Together in Faith: Young people version is going well. Adult one still needs more participants, Currently planning a mix of live and virtual events.
- e. Faith formation council is talking about the Parish Mission for 2022. Plan to be consistent with Divine Renovation themes. Fr. Jim Sichko is a possible speaker. Potential themes : Eucharist Mercy, kindness, trust. Decision needs to be made on this in the next 2 months.
