- a. ADA: \$399,000 assessment, currently at 64% of goal, this is \$43,000 more than we had at this time last year

    - Considering CRHP restart in fall of 2022 v.s April 2022
    - Newcomer's program will also restart and falls under the Parish Life coordinator.
